WHAT FUNDING DOES HEATH PARK RECEIVE AND WHO IS WAS THIS FOR?

Heath Park will receive funds in the academic year 2020 – 2021 to support

- 47 students who entered the school below the expected standard in Maths
- 39 students who entered the school below the expected standard in English

WHAT DID HEATH PARK DO WITH THE MONEY THAT YEAR?

- Additional time allocation for English and Maths teaching (additional curriculum time and after school activities)
- Learning Support Assistants dedicated to specific groups of students within Year 7 core lessons
- Targeted Year Lead support, with specific responsibility for this cohort of students
- Additional resources allocated to catch up provision
- Leadership responsibilities allocated to drive reading across the curriculum, with provision for identified groups of students
- Use of Hegarty Maths to support learning at home

HOW WILL IMPACT BE MEASURED?

Year 7 complete a series of common assessment tasks throughout the year and an end of year test in English and Maths, and progress will be monitored at each step. Where issues arise from CATs, additional support will be offered or support amended to ensure a greater impact
