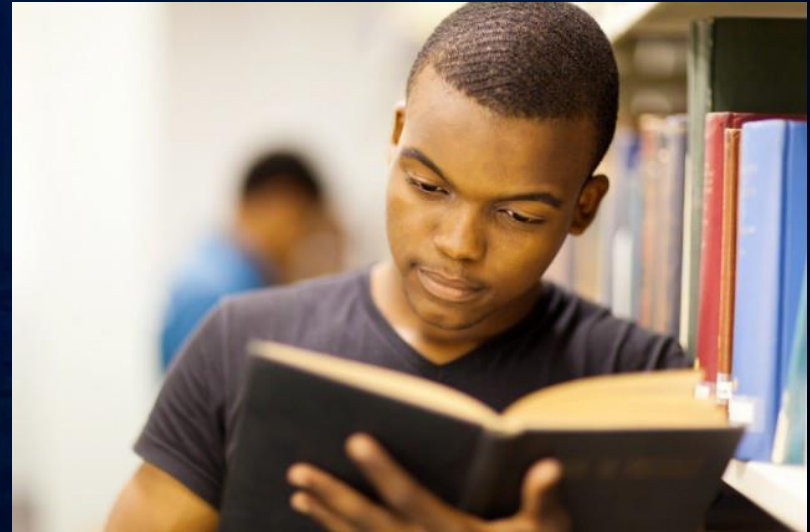

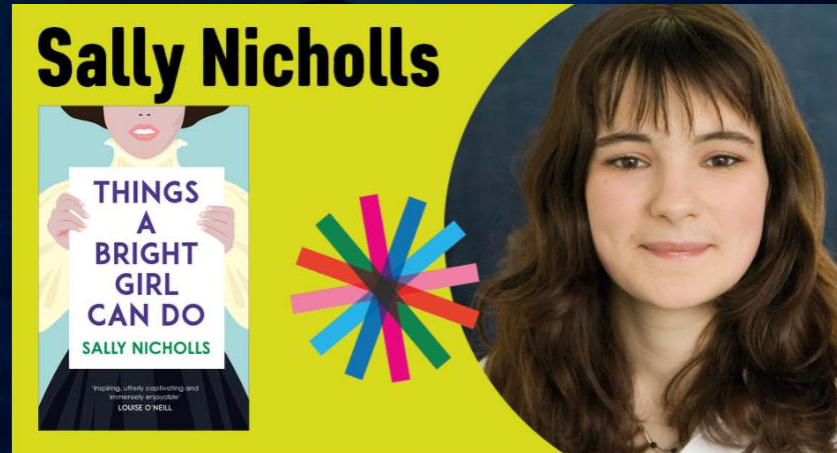


Things A Bright Girl Can Do – Sally Nicholls
