Dear Parent/Carer

We hope that you remain well and are keeping safe. It is so good to be able to write to you again and look ahead to your child's next steps in education as we welcome them and you to Heath Park.

As your child's primary school will have informed you, the local authority has worked with secondary schools to arrange induction from 5th July 2021. We are excited to meet our new Year 7 students and also feel it is important that your child is given an opportunity to spend some time in school with their new teachers and their peers.

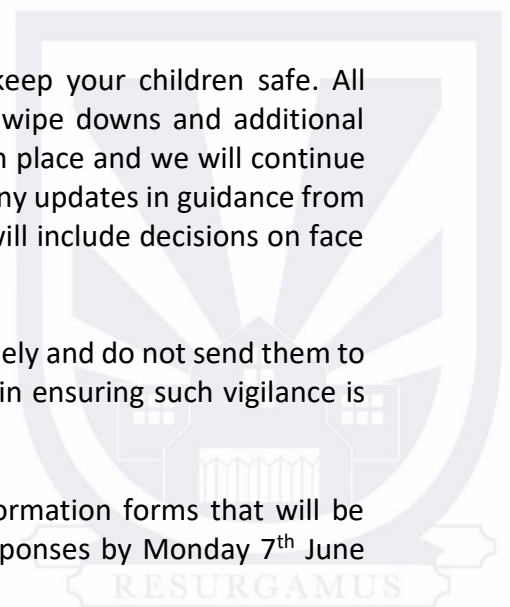
We would ask that you make arrangements to bring your child to Heath Park and have them collected at the end of the day. It is not advisable for your child to make their way home or leave school site alone at this stage. Your child should arrive at the rear entrance on Coronation Road between 9 and 9.15am on each of the dates stated at the top of this letter, where they will be greeted and taken into school. They will be released from the same point at 2.30pm.

Children will be provided with equipment for the days in school and are asked not to bring any equipment from home. They should attend the induction days wearing their primary school uniform. They may bring a snack for break if they wish and should bring their own filled water bottle. Food will be provided during the day.

Please be assured that Covid safe measures are in place to keep your children safe. All classrooms have been adapted, supported by hand sanitizing, wipe downs and additional cleaning. Year group bubbles and designated social spaces are in place and we will continue to monitor local transmission rates and respond accordingly to any updates in guidance from Public Health England and the Department for Education. This will include decisions on face coverings being worn in school.

We ask that you continue to monitor the health of your child closely and do not send them to school if they present any symptoms of Covid19. Your support in ensuring such vigilance is much appreciated.

Can I please ask that you complete and submit the online information forms that will be emailed out to you on Friday 28th May- we will require all responses by Monday 7th June



please as we cannot accept children into school without confirmation from these forms. The email will come from transition@heathpark.net. If you do not receive it on this day, please check your junk and clutter folders. Alternatively, all forms will also be available on our dedicated transition page on the website.

We are also planning to host a virtual information evening via teams on June 15th 4.30-5.30pm where we will take the opportunity to introduce key staff that will be supporting your child in Year 7 including their Head of Year and Form Tutor.
