Dear Parent / Guardian,

We hope that your child ended their time in primary school in good spirits, and although they will surely miss their friends and teachers, we cannot wait to greet them in September as our own. THE START OF THE NEW TERM

School starts for our new Year 7 on Friday 3rd September at 9:30am. They may enter either from Prestwood Road or Coronation Road but if you are dropping your child by car, we ask that you use Coronation Road to respect our neighbours and to ensure safety at the main entrance where the road is narrow and dangerous if packed with cars. The day finishes at the normal time of 3pm when students are released to make their way home.

STARTING SAFE

All children are asked to ensure that they have taken a Lateral Flow Test before their first day in school. We understand that practice in primary schools has been mixed and that not all children will have done such and your support with this is greatly appreciated. Kits can be ordered to be sent home through the NHS or there are centres around Wolverhampton who provide these onsite. If you require support from school, we have facilities in place so please let Miss Foster know that this is needed so that arrangements can be made.

FIRST DAY FOOD

We are a cashless school and as such, all monies for food must be processed through ParentPay. As we may not be set up for the first day, we will be providing food for all Year 7 students on the Friday, with the system up and running for all on the Monday. Your child is of course free to bring a packed lunch if they prefer.


