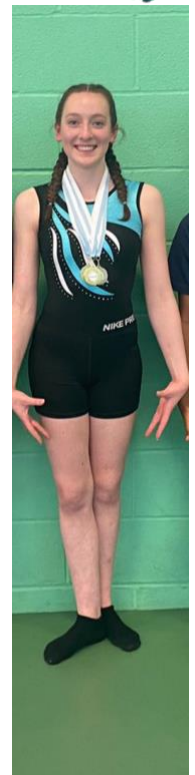

Our students were incredibly respectful and really enjoyed the event making it through to the semi finals! Well done!



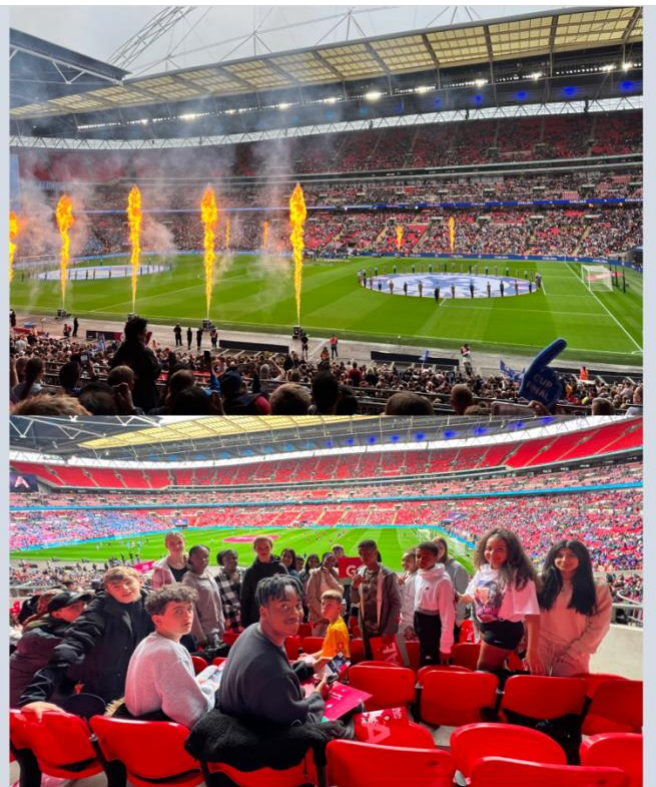
