We are very proud of them all!

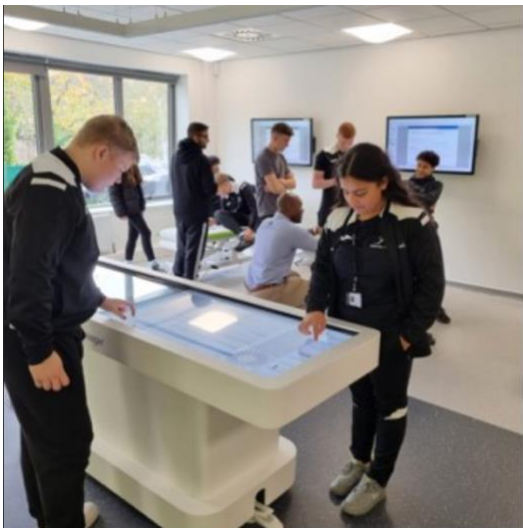


UNIFIED VOLLEYBALL EVENT
