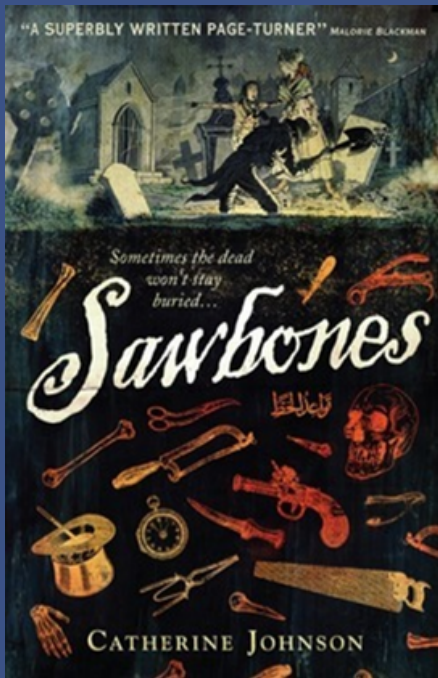

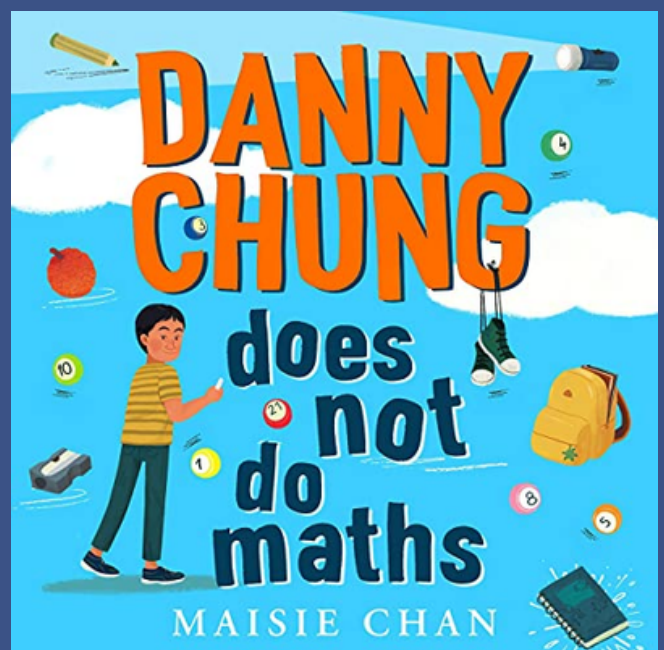
## SAWBONES

## School library

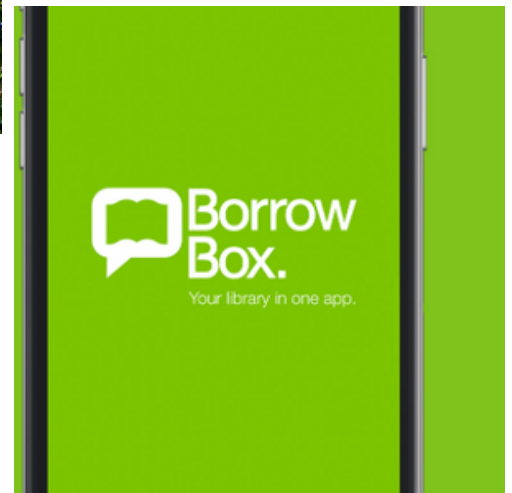
