English	<p>All students have access to <b>Seneca</b> and should use this to revise their GCSE Literature texts. It can also be used to revise the Language GCSE. There is a document in the Teams group with links to Seneca tasks and revision videos to support this. <a href="https://senecalearning.com/en-GB/">https://senecalearning.com/en-GB/</a></p> <p>Students will be completing all the GCSE AQA Language papers and GCSE AQA Literature papers for their mock. Ideally, students should be completing one section a week (45mins-1 hour e.g. A reading section from language paper 1 or AN Inspector Calls essay) in timed conditions to ensure they can write to the time provided by the exam board. This gives them a new quotation once a week for each Literature text and develops the analysis made before showing them the quotation in an essay on Friday. This is an excellent revision tool for boosting grades and can be used to make notes, revision cards, essay paragraph cards, and mind maps. Log in details have been sent to their school email.</p> <p>All students have access to the most important 20 quotations for each text (in the Teams folder too) and should be actively learning these for the exam season. They can use flashcards or look, cover, write, and check to test themselves.</p> <p>All students have access to an <b>Oxford Revise textbook</b> for GCSE Language which they can take home and use to support their revision. This is to be returned to school after the exams please.</p>
